The Story to Know

In 1925 Manzone Giovanni purchased "Ciabot del Preve" (the Parish Priest house) and he started the winemaking in Monforte d'Alba. During the years the Manzone family purchased important vineyards on the historic hill of "CASTELLETTO" and "GRAMOLERE", two of the best crus in Monforte d'Alba.

In the last years Mauro (2005) and Mirella Manzone (2012) joined their father Giovanni in the management of the winery. Mauro and Mirella are graduated from the famed Oenology School of Alba.

The entire production is focused on high- quality and limited to about 50,000 bottles per year.
