Gary Farrell. Yes THAT Gary Farrell. The iconic 35-year old pioneer of the Russian River Valley. Holy smokes friends, this is a bonkers deal from one of the most celebrated wineries in Sonoma County. And 50% off? 92pts from Enthusiast?! How did we do it? Magic. Just magic. Hurry on to the site to secure your allotment, we'll wait.

Named a Top 100 Winery by Wine & Spirits in 2019 and has garnered well over 350 90+ scores in the past several years, Gary Farrell is legendary. With ridiculous access to preeminent vineyards (think Rochioli, Bacigalupi Hallberg, Ritchie, Gap's Crown and Bien Nacido) for their Pinots and Chardonnays, they really pack the power with their small-lot single-vineyard Zinfandels. The historic Maffei Vineyard with gnarly, 90+ year old head-trained vines (a site that is also registered by the Historic Vineyard Society), is tended with love and devotion. The vines are meticulously managed with hand-leafing techniques for perfect light and dropping clusters for optimal vine balance. Gary Farrell is one of four wineries to have access to this fruit (others being Hartford and Seghesio). It's a special place and it shows in the bottle.

Beautiful florals are all over this with dark, brambly fruit, rich plums and hints of black currants, and white pepper. There's lovely acidity and bright notes of mulberries, cedar and sage with a lush profile of warm spices. Power, grace, velvety and palate-pleasing. It's a Zin for the Zin lovers and those who need a reason to fall back in love with this classic California variety.
